

Countryside Stewardship One-to-Ones

Applications for Countryside Stewardship (CS) Mid Tier including Wildlife Offers are now open and close on 29 July 2022.

Natural England, on behalf of the Rural Payments Agency, are providing free online one-to-one advice sessions to help you understand more about the Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier Scheme and develop a high quality application for an agreement that will benefit the local area and your farm business.

If you are thinking of applying this year, these events will provide an update on the scheme changes for agreements commencing 1 January 2023, how the scheme works, eligibility, and what your local area environmental priorities are. They will also explain land management and capital grant opportunities available through the scheme.

We have made it quicker and easier to apply for CS Mid Tier this year using the Rural Payments Service. For more information go to www.gov.uk/rpa/cs. Alternatively call the Rural Payments Agency (RPA) on 03000 200 301.

These advice sessions will be delivered remotely via an online teleconference facility or telephone. To get the most out of a one-to-one session, it is advisable to have access to a computer with internet capabilities. Your free one-to-one session will last up to 1hr 30mins with an experienced adviser who will provide guidance on the most suitable Mid Tier options for your farm and how to complete your application. It is helpful if you have an idea of what you want to achieve with your application prior to your session.
