

What does it all mean? With countries and organisations all in a race to achieve net zero emissions, and increase biodiversity, carbon markets are projected to increase 15-fold, with most of that growth estimated to come from nature-based solutions: tree planting, peatland restoration and – potentially – soil carbon. Can farmers look to the new environmental markets to farm profitably and make up the shortfall from BPS? Are there too many demands on our land and how do we choose? We will explore these nature-based solutions and the potential opportunities. Alongside other panelists (TBC) we will be joined by CLA Senior Land Use Policy Adviser Graham Clark and Tom Mason, Environment Bank Head of Land (South West). The morning's debate will be chaired by Deputy President Victoria Vyvyan.

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OPEN-AIR DAIRY

Nestled in the beautiful Dorset countryside at Littlebredy, near Dorchester, Tom and his business partner Neil Grigg milk 580 spring calving free range cows. The cows live outside all year round and they are milked in the field through mobile milking parlours. The parlours are taken to the cows wherever they are grazing. Tom and Neil manufacture their milking parlours for other farmers and sell their cheese under the open-air dairy brand.

The cows live a laid-back way of life at Littlebredy. It's believed that this makes the cows happier, healthier and what makes the cheddar taste so great!

Tom Foot has invited CLA members on a tour of the open-air dairy. We will have a tour of the farm then head over to the fields to watch the open-air dairy in action followed by some cheese tasting.

Please ensure to where sensible footwear and suitable clothing for the weather. We advise bringing bottled water in case it is hot.



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WOMEN'S NETWORK Visit to Lynher Dairies with Catherine Mead

The CLA Women's Network was set up in 2020 by CLA Director General Sarah Hendry to encourage more women to be active in the CLA and create networking, mentoring and social opportunities for members.

Lynher Dairies are the sole producers of the iconic nettle-wrapped Cornish Yarg, Wild Garlic Yarg, Cornish Kern - a Supreme Champion at the World Cheese Awards - and the local's favourite, buttery Stithians. The delicious cheeses are made by hand in open vats from the creamy milk produced by our own Ayrshires and other carefully selected herds. Happy cows are at the heart of the Lynher Dairies ethos.

Owned by Catherine Mead OBE, the small dairy is based in Ponsanooth, near Truro. Based on a 17th century recipe, they paint the foraged leaves, nettle, or wild garlic, on to the cheeses to create Yarg and let nature do the rest. The Stithians and Kern cheeses are encased in wax as they mature for longer.

Their award-winning cheeses can be found in specialist cheese shops, farm shops and delis across the UK and further afield.

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LAMORRAN HOUSE GARDENS TOUR

Lamorran is a subtropical, Italianate inspired garden on Cornwall's beautiful Roseland peninsula.

A garden of many levels, it is situated on a south facing slope, and is surrounded on three sides by the benign influence of the warming sea. St Anthony's headland sits across the water, creating a protected inlet to St Mawes and the river beyond.

These unique conditions mean that the garden remains frost free in all but the most serious of winters; the last recorded frost being in 1987. A wide range of plants from all over the world is therefore able to be grown, resulting in something of a plantsperson's paradise. An extensive, eclectic and unusual range of plants can be found, with particular emphasis on southern hemisphere and sub-tropical flora.

Many features are included to divide the garden into intimate compartments which the visitor can find and explore. There are areas of woodland, a water garden in Japanese style as well as temples and archways in the steeper parts of the garden, and a small bridge on which to lean and look out over the bay exhibiting a distinctly Venetian influence.

The guiding principle behind the garden has been the desire to create tranquillity and beauty in harmony with nature

CLA members will be greeted by a gardener for a welcome talk, you can then view the gardens at your own leisure followed by a Q&A with the gardener. We will then be seated on the veranda for tea & coffee and a selection of cakes and scones.


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
